

# Rail grinding noise notice

## Ferny Grove to Coopers Plains

As part of an ongoing maintenance program, rail grinding is scheduled to be carried out on the network between Monday 16 and Sunday 29 October and is expected to be in your local area between 10pm and 5am on the following dates:

- Ferny Grove through to Coopers Plains – Monday 16 and Tuesday 17 October
- Roma Street to Fortitude Valley – Wednesday 18 and Thursday 19 October

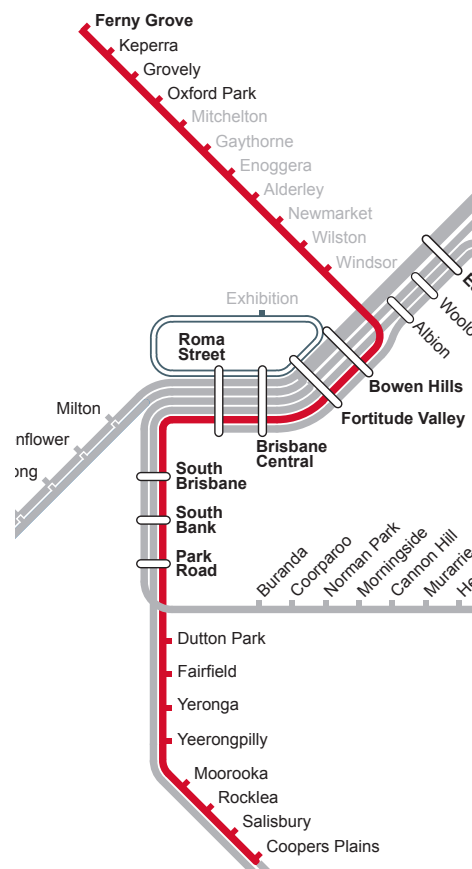
The rail grinding machine, or grinder, is an on-track machine that grinds the track to remove irregularities which improves safety, and provides a smoother ride for our customers. The grinder can only operate safely at night when there are no trains on the line, and is stored at a nearby location during the day.

Residents nearest the rail corridor may be exposed to periods of loud noise. Typically, the grinder works on a particular section of the track for up to 20 minutes at a time.

Queensland Rail will make every effort to carry out these works with respect for our valued neighbours and we apologise for any inconvenience.

Dates, times and locations are subject to change to meet operational requirements. For example the grinder may be in your area a day earlier than listed. For any greater changes to the schedule, we will endeavour to send out an updated notice where possible.
