Everton Hills residents appeal for better bus service

Member for Everton, Tim Mander has endorsed a local petition to improve bus services for residents in Everton Hills.

He said the current routes no longer cater for current and future population growth in the vicinity of Henderson, Buckland and Bennetts Roads.

“With the daily commute becoming more and more hectic, it is important to provide commuters with ease of access to efficient and reliable public transport, and to reduce the ever increasing number of cars on the road.”

Local Real Estate Agent and principal petitioner Beth Lagos of Harcourts Solutions said potential buyers always ask about a property’s nearest public transport.
